Sunny Jim Fitzsimmons ended his illustrious career as a trainer with another stakes winner, and his 2,267th victory, when Wheatley Stable's King's Story won the Miss Woodford Stakes by six lengths. Bonnie's Girl in a challenge in the stretch was unable to catch the leader. Coming from 10th in the field of 16 at the top of the stretch, Lizzie Tish grabbed third, a nose behind the runner-up.

Bred by Mrs. H. C. Phipps' Wheatley Stable, King's Story has always raced under the Wheatley colors.

Her third stakes attempt brought her first win. As a 2-year-old, she finished fifth in the National Stallion Stakes and third in the Astoria Stakes, and was weighted at 107 on the Experimental Handicap, one of eight foals from Bold Ruler's first crop to be rated. She is the fourth foal from Narrative and the second filly stakes winner, and is a half-sister to the 1960 Test Stakes winner Brave Pilot. Narrative, barren for the last three seasons, has been bred to *Ribot for 1964.

The second dam produced 1962 stakes winner Royal Record, and King's Story's third dam is the foundation mare *La Troienne, which has produced five stakes winners, including Black Helen (\$61,800) and Bimelech (\$248,745), and seven producers of stakes winners, including



Baby League. Ten stakes winners trace directly to her on the tail-female line.

Bold Ruler was the seventh leading sire of 2-year-olds last year, when representatives of his first crop earned \$170,645. He entered the stud in 1959, and in his first crop has sired six stakes winners—Lamb Chop, Speedwell, Bold Commander, Bold Princess, and Ornamento. In his second crop this year, he has had Chieftain and Beautiful Day. Bold Ruler, owned by Wheatley Stable, stands at Claiborne Farm, near Paris, Ky.
