

# TRIBUTES POUR IN FOR SUNNY JIM

The body of racing's beloved Sunny Jim Fitzsimmons reposed yesterday on the site where, on July 23, 1874, he was born. James Edward Fitzsimmons died Friday at Cedars of Lebanon Hospital in Miami. The body of the man who trained thoroughbred horses that won \$12 million in his 80-year career was at the John J. Healey Funeral Home in the Sheepshead Bay section of Brooklyn.

The funeral home is on the site where Sunny Jim was born and where later was erected the old Sheepshead Bay racetrack.

Visiting hours were set for 1-5 p. m. and 7-10 p. m. today and tomorrow. Hundreds paid tribute to Mr. Fitz yesterday. The family requested that no flowers be sent, that donations be made to the Shrine of the Immaculate Conception in Washington.

A solemn Requiem Mass will be said at 9:30 a. m. Tuesday and burial will follow at Holy Cross Cemetery in Brooklyn.
